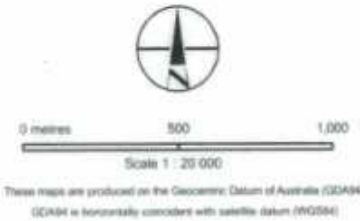


Phytophthora (Root-rot fungus)
Phytophthora (fy-TOFF-thora), otherwise known as root-rot fungus is killing our native plants and threatens the survival of animals depending on plants for food and shelter. This introduced fungus occurs near the Yurrebilla Trail in plant roots, soil and water. Please help stop the spread by staying on tracks and trails and by complying with all *Phytophthora* management signs. *Phytophthora*-Hygiene Stations (for cleaning your footwear) are located along the trail and are marked on the map. Other Hygiene Stations are located throughout the parks.

Some sections of the Yurrebilla Trail traverse private land. At all times please respect property and stock by keeping to the trail.
